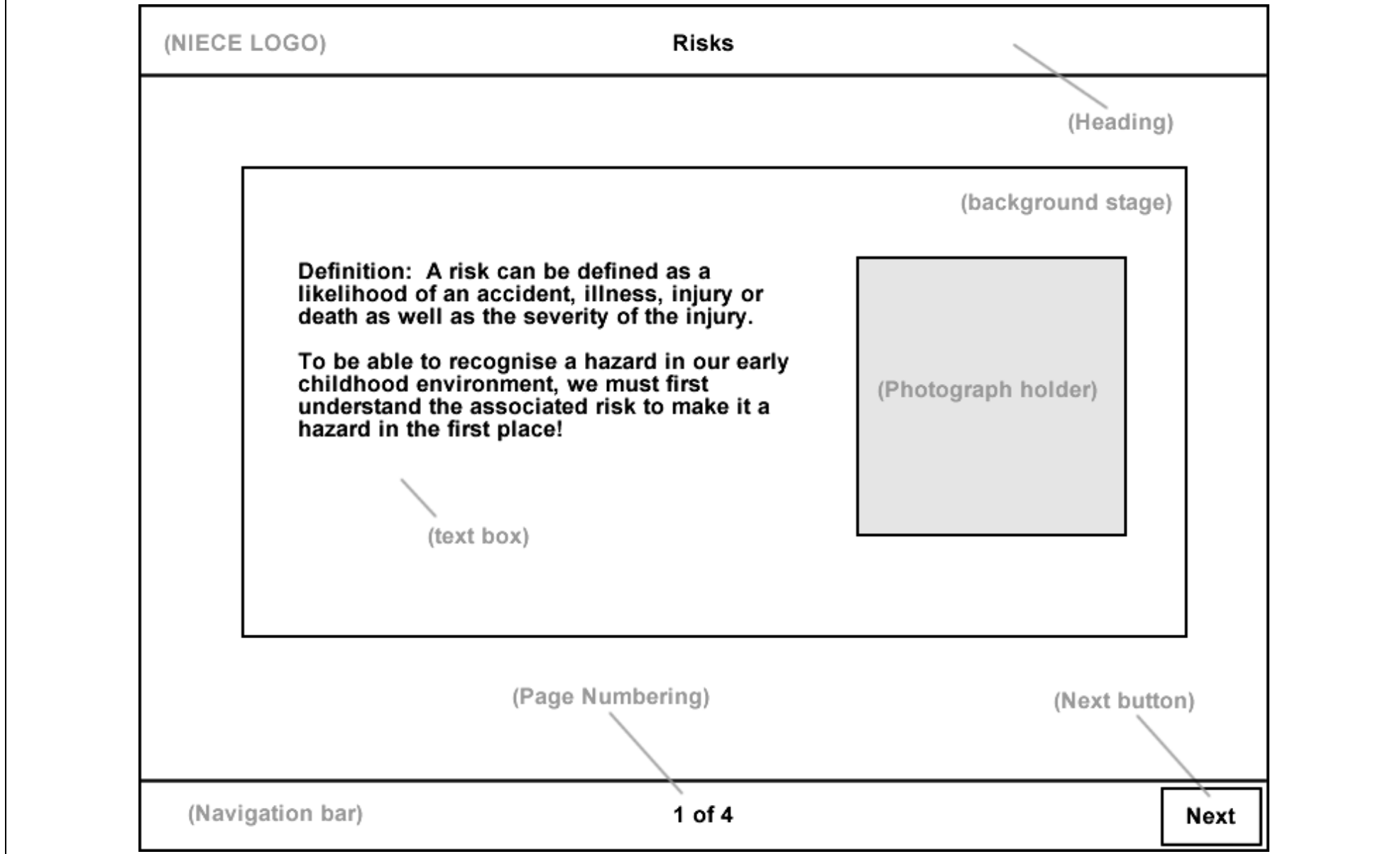

Programming

1. User drags the **Hazards** to the associated **Risk**.
2. If the user gets a correct match then the **correct response** appears (**Screen 2a**).
3. If the user does not get a match the **incorrect response** appears (**Screen 2b**).
4. Once all are in their correct positions, the **Congratulations response** appears (**Screen 2c**).
